[Canvassing May 2, 2026 General Election]

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LUCAS, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION OF THE CITY OF LUCAS, TEXAS, HELD IN THE CITY OF LUCAS, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, ON MAY 2, 2026, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR SEAT NO. 1 AND SEAT NO. 2 TO SERVE THREE (3) YEAR TERMS, BEGINNING MAY 21, 2026; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2026, a General Election was held in the City of Lucas, Collin County, Texas, for the purpose of electing two (2) council members;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LUCAS, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. After canvassing the returns of said election pursuant to the Charter and ordinances of the City of Lucas and pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, including the early voting votes, the City Council, acting as canvassing authority, certifies the following are true and correct results, to-wit:

SECTION 2. Said election was duly and timely called by the City Council as required by the Texas Election Code; notice of said election was given in accordance with the law; the election was conducted as required; and, the canvass of the votes cast in said election and returns thereof was made in accordance with the law.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to the City Charter of the City of Lucas and applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, the following individuals have been elected to serve as Council Members for Seat No. 1 and Seat No.2 on the Lucas City Council for a term of three (3) years:

1. Jonathan Underhill, Council Member Seat 1 (through May 2029)
2. Rebecca B Orr., Council Member Seat 2 (through May 2029)

SECTION 4. If any part or parts of this Resolution are found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court having competent jurisdiction, then such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining parts thereof and such remaining parts shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
