Case will be continued and no action will be taken to conduct a public hearing to consider a request for a Planned Development (PD) submitted by Lexi Cassels on behalf of Toll Brothers Homes and the Paxton Family Trust for approximately 153.633 acres, generally located at the southeast corner of South Angel Parkway and Estates Parkway, known as Lucas Farm. The proposed PD includes approximately 117.003 acres for single-family residential development and 36.630 acres for commercial development. **(Joe Hilbourn, Development Services Director)**
5. Case will be continued and no action will be taken to conduct a public hearing to consider a request for a Planned Development (PD) zoning district to overlay Commercial Business (CB) for approximately 37.195 acres located along Southview Drive (FM 1378), within the James Anderson Survey, Abstract No. 17.
